- 3. Financially responsible parent/guardian must submit prior year tax return (first 2 pages of 1040) with this application.
- 4. Recipients will receive up to \$5,000 each; typically \$1,000, \$2,500, or \$5,000 awarded per student.
- 5. \$80,000/year with a total of 31 scholarships can be awarded each year.

Procedure for Application:

- 1. The AAA Worthy Student Committee will review all applications received on an ongoing basis up to the first day of school. If approved, monthly scholarship amounts will be reduce monthly tuition bills.
- 2. The application is due no later than July 31 of each year for all returning students and as soon as possible for new applicants, but no later than the 2^{nd} week of school.
